



Tim Wu is a professor at Columbia Law School, specializing in telecommunications law, copyright, and international trade. He is the co-author of *Who Controls the Internet?* (Oxford U. Press 2006), and a writer for *Slate* Magazine. In 2006 Wu was recognized as one of the year's 50 leaders in science and technology by *Scientific American* magazine.

Tim Wu previously worked in the telecommunications industry in Silicon Valley, and was a law clerk for Judge Richard Posner and Justice Stephen Breyer. He graduated from McGill University (B.Sc), and Harvard Law School, and has taught at the University of Virginia, the University of Chicago, and Stanford Law School.
